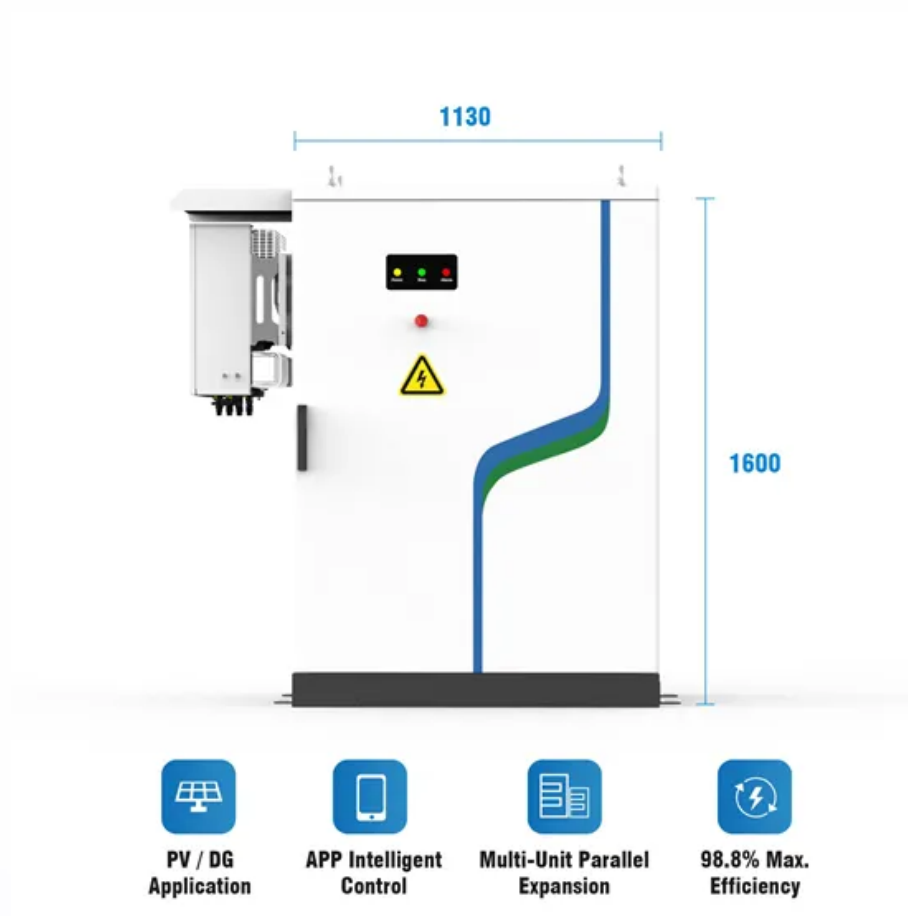


How much current does a 12 volt inverter 2000w have



Overview

A 12V 2000W inverter running at maximum load draws 166. Divide the watts consumed per hour by the voltage and you get the amps.

The current draw from a 12V or 24V battery when running an inverter depends on the actual load, not the inverter size. A quick rule is to divide watts by 10 for 12V systems or 20 for 24V systems.

Generally, a 2,000W inverter can draw as much as 240 amps if running on a 12-volt battery bank. Divide that amperage by half if using a 24V battery unit. Note that you can use Ohm's

What Size Wire for a 2000 Watt Inverter?

Assuming a typical efficiency of 90%, the inverter must draw more power from the battery to output 2000 watts, increasing the actual current to about 185 amps.
