Overview

Islamabad, June 25, 2025: Power generation in Pakistan rose slightly by 1% year-on-year (YoY) in May 2025, reaching 12,755 gigawatt-hours (GWh), official data revealed. Despite the uptick, generation levels remained below the benchmark set for the month.

Recent reforms include the unbundling and corporatization of the Water and Power Development Authority (WAPDA) into 10 regional distribution companies, 4 government-owned thermal power generation companies and a transmission company, the National Transmission and Despatch Company. The hydropower plants were retained by WAPDA as WAPDA Hydroelectric. All are fully owned by the government. K-Electric Limited (formally known as Karachi Electric Supply Company), which is respon
