

# The largest solar container battery in Athens



## Overview

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The project, deploying 36 containerized units with 3.44MWh nominal capacity each, has seen all equipment arrive on-site. Commissioning has officially commenced, marking the critical final phase of construction for one of the world's largest PV-ESS self-consumption projects.
